The following amounts are an estimate of typical first-year expenses, based on a survey of our students. Individuals' expenses may vary in one category or another, depending upon their situations. However, the U.S. Department of Education regulates that the total amount of financial aid a student receives cannot exceed the total Cost of Attendance shown here. "Financial aid" includes all money that is obtained from scholarships, loans, pre-paid tuition plans, service contracts, tuition waivers, living stipends, etc. The Department also regulates that the Cost of Attendance must be limited to the time period of D.O. academic work, which is 48 weeks (11 months) for OMS1 students.

Suggested Budget (an individual student's actual expenses by category may vary)

Supplies and Equipment	\$3,400
Includes required books and supplemental materials, computer and printer, general supplies, medical equipment, scrubs, and white coats.	
Housing and Utilities	\$18,000
Includes rent, renter's insurance, electricity, water, sewer, garbage, phone, internet, cable, and a general housing allowance.	
Meals	\$5,400
Includes groceries and restaurants.	
Transportation and Travel	\$8,800
Includes car payment, car insurance, gas, maintenance, repairs, and a personal travel allowance.	
Medical and Personal Expenses	\$3,550
Includes unreimbursed medical expenses (vision, dental, etc.), clothing, entertainment, and emergency expenses.
