Haywood Regional Medical Center is located in Haywood County and is licensed for 153 beds. The hospital was created in 1927 as the first county hospital in North Carolina. Later rebuilding in 1978 to our new location in Clyde. In 2014, the hospital was acquired by Duke Lifepoint.

Residency Programs:

While HRMC does have a Residency program on site of their own, we do have MAHEC (Mountain Area Health Education Center) general surgery residents rotating with our general surgery group.

You will have the opportunity to have several different didactic lectures with various hospital disciplines monthly. There are also Grand Rounds through UNC Pardee that you will have the opportunity to attend via Zoom.

The Monthly OMM lab will be led by Dr. McAlvany as well as other HRMC employed DO's at the Health and Fitness Center

Site Orientation:

Prior to starting your clinical rotation, students will be required to participate in an orientation of the facility. During this time, you will receive all your IT access for both the inpatient and outpatient EMR systems as well as training. This orientation will be the last week of July.
