

Spartanburg Regional Healthcare System is an integrated healthcare delivery system that provides care from one's birth through the senior years. Serving seven counties with five hospitals and many specialty centers, SRHS has been a partner within a growing community for more than 95 years. Over the years, we have received national recognition for our care, compassion and technological excellence.

- Spartanburg Medical Center is a 540 bed research and teaching hospital with a fully accredited Level 1 Trauma Center.
- Spartanburg Medical Center Mary Black Campus has provided healthcare to the Upstate. Now a part of Spartanburg Regional Healthcare System (SRHS), the facility features surgical suites, nationally credentialed (CARF) inpatient rehabilitation, a 24-bed emergency department,

intensive care unit, geriatric psychiatric services, a joint care program, cardiology services and a sleep center.

- Pelham Medical Center is a 48 bed, acute care facility with an emergency center, medical office building and numerous practices and amenities.
- Union Medical Center is a 59 bed hospital with emergency services, inpatient/observation care and outpatient diagnostics.
- Spartanburg Hospital for Restorative Care provides 97 beds as a long term acute care hospital with a 25 bed skilled nursing facility.
- Ellen Sagar Nursing Center operates with 113 beds and offers skilled nursing and rehabilitation services.
- In-home hospice, a 15 bed Hospice Home and an experience palliative care team for the comfort care and support of patients with life limiting illnesses.
- Medical Group of the Carolinas (MGC), over 300 physicians in offices located throughout our six-county service area.
- Gibbs Cancer Center and Research Institute, with four locations across the Upstate, including Spartanburg, Greer, Gaffney and Union.
