Hospital Information

Lewis Gale Alleghany is located in Low Moor, Virginia – about 45 minutes from Roanoke. This smaller HCA community hospital is licensed for 209 beds. It serves 8 counties in Virginia and West Virginia.

VCOM Housing

VCOM rents a three bedroom, two bath house in close proximity to the hospital for third year students. If available, fourth year students can also use this housing.

Site Orientation

All students are required to complete paperwork and on-line training prior to the start of their rotations. Since there are usually only a few students each rotation period, the staff at AGH holds ‘mini’ orientations the first day of each rotation period.
