

Hospital Information

Augusta Health, Inc. (AH), an independent, not-for-profit, rural community health system, located in Augusta County, Virginia in the heart of the scenic and historic Shenandoah Valley. Inpatient Beds – 255

Specialty Services – Heart & Vascular Center, Primary Stroke Center, Comprehensive Cancer Program

AH provides a full range of outpatient services, including both medical and radiation oncology cancer treatment, diagnostic and interventional cardiovascular services, a pain management center, a behavioral health center, a Nursing Treatment Center, and a sleep lab facility.

Since opening in 1994, the hospital has received national distinction having been designated as a Solucient 100 Top Hospital twice, 100 Top Regional hospital once, U.S. News and World Report's America's Best Hospitals three times, and has received the HealthGrades Distinguished Hospital Award for Clinical Excellence the last 4 out of 5 years, which places us in the top 5% of all hospitals in the country. AH is financially prosperous as evidenced by its Moody's A1 rating, being one of only two hospitals its size in the nation to hold that level of credit worthiness.
