Jack Hughston Memorial Hospital is a modern 70 bed facility in Phenix City, Alabama, comprising a full surgical suite, an eight-bed ICU, full-service diagnostic imaging department with a 64-slice CT Scanner, MRI, mammography, X-ray, ultrasound, and a 24-hour emergency services department receiving 30,000 visits per year.
